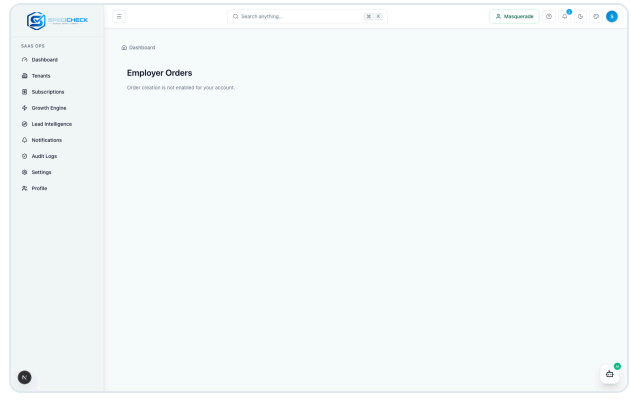

End-to-End Workflow (What Your Team Runs Daily)

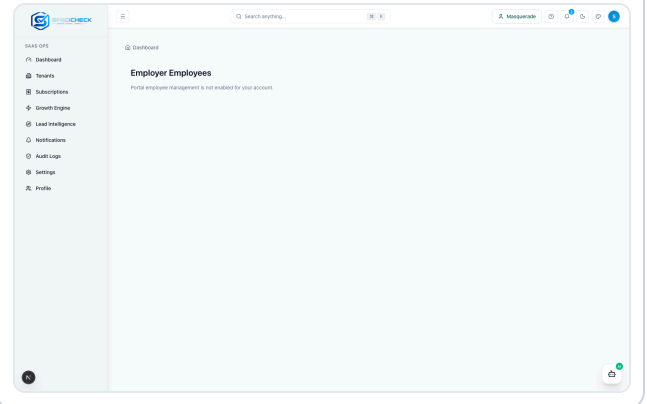
1. A screening request is created.

Employer Portal Orders



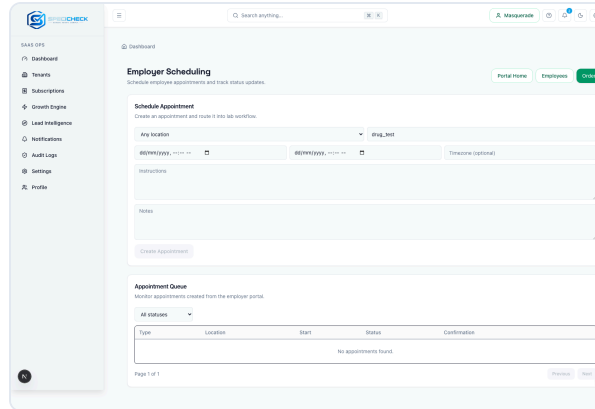

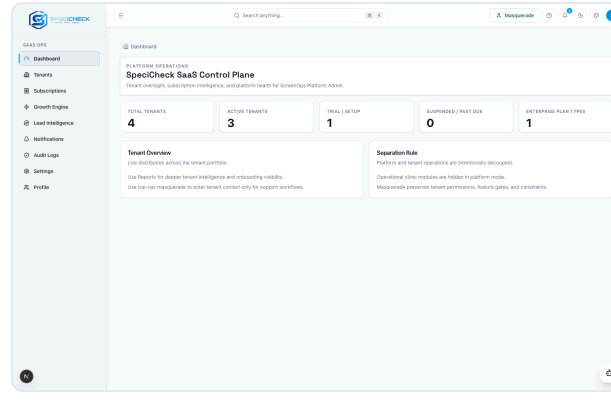
2. The donor is scheduled and checked in.

Employer Portal Scheduling



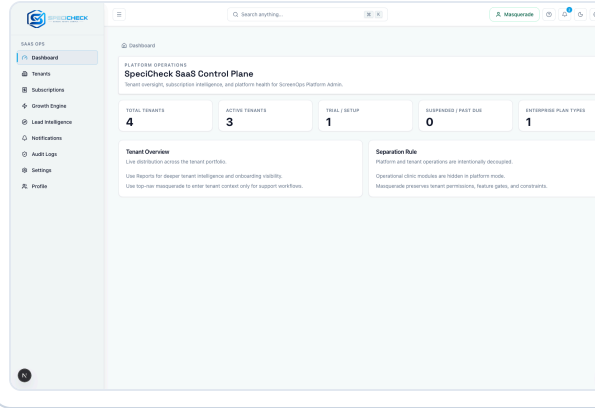
Check-Ins Queue



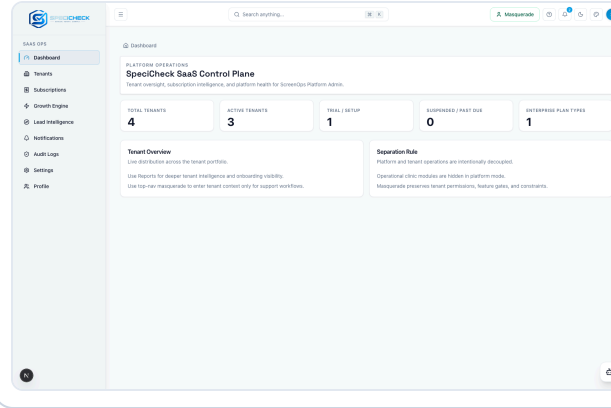
3. Specimen collection and tracking steps are completed.

Specimen Tracking



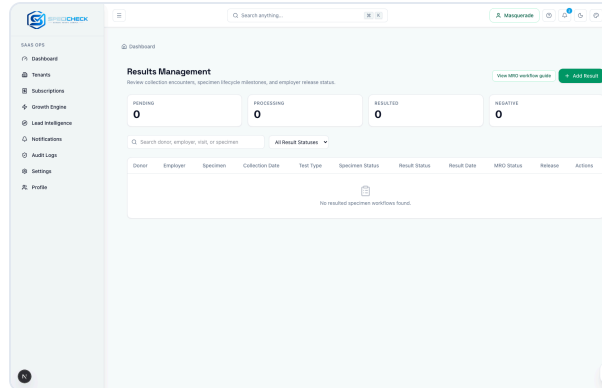

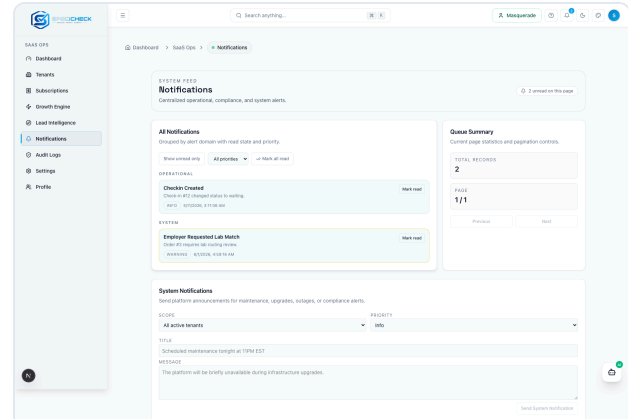
4. Results are processed and released.

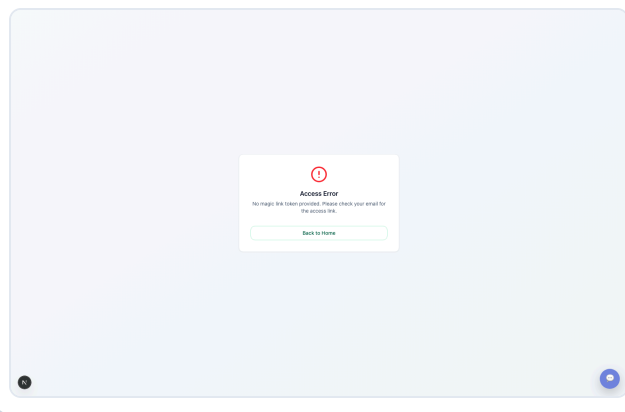

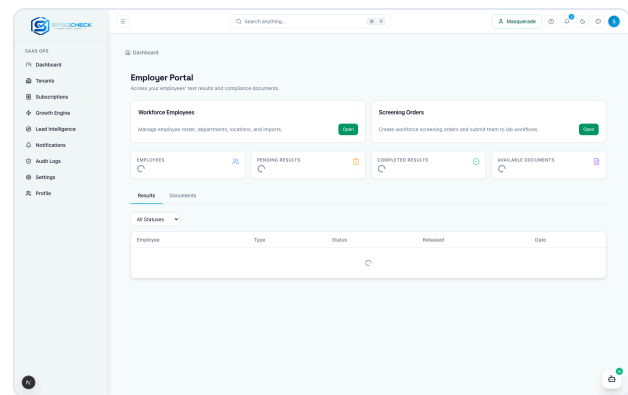
5. Employers access released results/documents in portal workflows.
